Obtaining a C2B2 Sponsoring PI:

- All applicants are required to find their sponsoring Project Investigator (PI) prior to submitting an application.
- If you have a PI in mind, contact that person directly. If you are not familiar with C2B2 PIs, visit one of the following links to identify someone in your field of research:

- Visit the PI's web site to learn about their research and obtain contact information. Once you have identified someone you think would be a good candidate to work with, call or e-mail the PI to inquire about sponsorship. If the PI you contact is unable to sponsor you at this time, please identify and contact another C2B2 PI in your field. REMEMBER: it is the responsibility of each applicant to find their own sponsoring PI.
- Once a PI has agreed to sponsor you, you will need to obtain the PI's curricula vitae and work with him/her to create a research proposal as these are 2 required elements of your fellowship application.
- Sponsoring PIs are responsible for paying the fellow's health benefits, supplies and research-related travel costs.
